1. PROJECT AGAAZ - Educational Campaign

The Project Aagaaz is about empowering everyone with the weapon of **knowledge and education**. It's a continuous on-going project. A variety of activities are held under it: (not limited to) **regular cost-free classes with tutors, stationary, boards and study material distribution, students' admissions in the schools with all their expenses regarding their education covered, personality development, IT & Spoken English classes, co-curricular activities** etc. Some special events like picnics, lunch and important days along with festive celebrations with the needy are also held. The underprivileged enter our sessions with hope to learn something new and we ensure that they return overwhelmed.



2. PROJECT JAGRITI - Mission Awareness

This project is set apart because it aims to **create awareness** about every field that affects the life of an individual along with **garments distribution, food distribution, woollens' distribution, recollection and service**, and other activities. It has been conducting **workshops, camps, street plays and awareness campaigns** to aware people about the importance of education, **health awareness**, making women aware of their rights, **environmental awareness** etc. Events do not just include sessions on **human rights awareness, women empowerment, role of education, child rights and protection**, but they extend much beyond to create awareness in fields like computers which play a vital role in our lives today.



3. PROJECT LAKSHAY - Competitions & Olympiads

Project Lakshay conducts different kinds of **Competitions and Olympiads** taken from various aspects and fields. Usually competitions are education-based and provide a platform to students to apply their classroom's theoretical knowledge into practical; however, what about **those who have never got a chance to be to a classroom**. We conduct six competitions, which go beyond mere academia. Our **main motive behind conducting these competitions is to explore hidden talents among children**. These talents could include anything like **art & craft, creative writing, singing, dancing** etc.



4. PROJECT VIDYA - Library, Computer Labs and Silai centre set-ups

Project Vidya is an initiative to nurture **reading habits** and skills in children and adults of all age groups from the underprivileged and remote areas. It aims to facilitate them with **computer facilities and labs, libraries equipped with good academic and non - academic literature, Silai Centres with machines and material, along with teachers in all areas to guide them properly**. These include a variety of books from literature in Hindi & English to Maths, Science, Arts, Computers, language learning, magazines, news, along with educational tools and kits for sparking learning spirits via games, story books and from comedy to books on life & psychology across all ages. Additionally, we also **donate books** to a variety of places and underprivileged people before **introducing libraries** in such locations. As we know, computers are the world of tomorrow, their immense usefulness is well-known. All computers are equipped with **basic software** that fulfils the threshold of a basic tech foundation. Children aren't the only underprivileged; hence, we don't limit facilities of learning and making a living only for children, but women through our **Silai Centres** and other **vocational/soft skills training**. We are putting our best efforts towards this amazing program. The noble deed will enable the underprivileged to enjoy the wonders life has to offer, and will also prosper in our nurturing environment.
